Pool Hours

The Plymouth Park Pool is an outdoor pool which features a shallow area for zero depth entry, special spray features and an area that can accommodate starting blocks for competitive racing.

Join us this summer for swimming lessons, open and lap swimming and special events. The pool opens the second Saturday in June and closes on Labor Day.

Plymouth Pool passes are available at the Parks and Recreation Department 4811 N. Saginaw Rd., Monday-Friday, 8am-5pm and will be available on-site at the pool, after pool opens and during pool hours.

Swim Lessons

Lessons are available for 7 levels of swimming ability and are taught by American Red Cross certified instructors. Classes meet Monday-Thursday for two weeks. The cost per each two-week session is \$40.00 and each class lasts 45 minutes. All classes are held at Plymouth Pool.
