







## New and Exciting at GADML in September

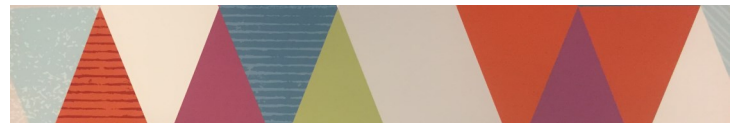
