Instructions for Application for Fire Safety Plan Examination

- All submittals must be accompanied by an Application for Fire Safety Plan Examination
 - Provide all requested information
- Construction documents shall be signed and sealed by an architect or professional engineer licensed in the State of Michigan as required by 1980 PA 299.
 - Fire suppression and fire alarm shop drawings are not required to be sealed by a design professional.
- **All fees will be billed to the appropriate business owner or contractor upon completion of the plan review.**
- All floor plans shall indicate exit locations, identify all room uses, and sprinkler coverage if any.
- Furnish approved design numbers for all fire related assemblies.
- Changes to previously reviewed drawings must be specifically brought to our attention for review and comment.
- Project description: Please indicate floor or work site to assist in identifying the project locations, as well as square footage of new building, addition, remodeling etc; square footage of existing building; project scope (description of project)

FIRE DEPARTMENT SERVICE FEES

On March 1st 2012, The Midland Fire Department will be implementing a fee schedule as adopted by City Council. Any questions regarding fees or billing may be directed to the Midland Fire Department administrative office at 989-837-3410.

Sec. 21-165. Fire department service fees.

Fees for services provided by the City of Midland Fire Department in accordance with Chapter 8 of the Code Ordinances shall be:

- (1) Annual and semi-annual fire safety inspections will be performed at no charge.
- (2) 1st follow-up inspection \$50
- (3) Additional follow-up inspections \$100 each
- (4) Third party inspections by NFPA or State of Michigan certified inspectors may be accepted at the discretion of the Midland Fire Department.
- (5) Certificate of occupancy and Change of occupancy inspections which include temporary certificates of occupancy as well as one (1) re-inspection.
 1. Ultra low hazard \$100.00
 2. Low hazard \$150.00
 3. Moderate hazard \$575.00
 4. High hazard \$975.00
 5. Hotels/motels and nursing homes/assisted living facilities \$95.00 per building, plus \$5.75 per room
- (6) Acceptance testing and temporary use permits. For purposes of this section "after hours" shall be defined as hours outside of normal Fire Prevention Division hours of operation.
 1. Valid complaints \$50.00
 2. Valid life safety complaints \$150.00
 3. Hot work operations \$50.00
 4. Fireworks displays \$95.00
 5. Blasting \$95.00
 6. Sprinkler system testing \$150
 7. Fire pump testing \$150.00
 8. Fire alarm testing \$150.00
 9. Commercial range hood suppression systems (acceptance testing) \$100.00
 10. Clean agent system (acceptance testing) \$100.00 per unit and per test
 11. Smoke control systems (acceptance testing) \$100.00 per system and per test
 12. Kiosk displays/booths/concession stands \$50.00
 13. Mall displays \$65.00
 14. Tents and other temporary membrane structures over 200 square feet \$125.00 (includes permit)
 15. Places of assembly (event) \$50.00; \$100.00 for afterhours inspections
 16. Exhibits and trade shows \$50.00; \$100.00 for afterhours inspections.
 17. Open flame \$50.00; \$100.00 for afterhours inspections
- (7) Plan review fees:
 1. Sprinkler systems (including foam systems) \$0.008 per square foot of building area **with \$250.00 minimum**
 2. Fire pumps \$200 (not included in sprinkler plan review fee)
 3. Stand pipe \$200.00 (combination stand pipe and riser plans shall be reviewed under the sprinkler system schedule)
 4. Commercial range hood systems \$150.00; additional systems reviewed at the same time and for the same building \$100.00
 5. Clean agent, carbon dioxide or other similar systems \$150.00
 6. Fire alarm/detection systems \$90.00 per hour, one (1) hour minimum
 7. Building life safety \$90.00 per hour, one (1) hour minimum
 8. Flammable, combustible, compressed liquid and gas storage \$90.00 per hour, one (1) hour minimum
 9. Spectator seating review 1 to 1,000 seats \$200.00; over 1,000 seats shall be \$200.00 plus \$20.00 for each additional 20 seats
